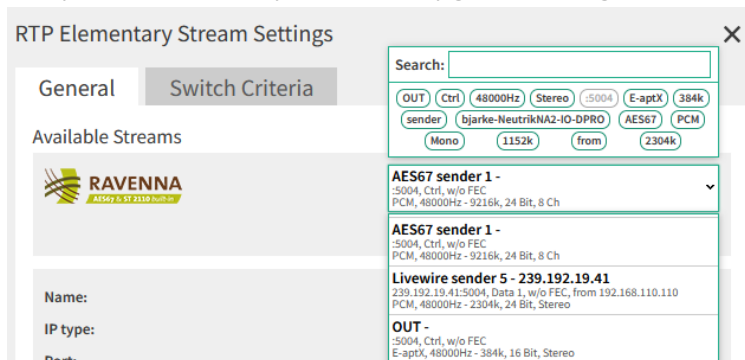

Fixed Issues

- TS Decoder: decoding of AAC may stop after some stream interruptions and doesn't recover even after the incoming stream is good again (CSM-1581)
- Wrong audio track might be selected in "Service from list (fixed PID)" mode when entering TS/Demux dialog
- SCTE-35 implementation may stop working after a while (CSM-1608)
- AES67 output may have a jitter of some milliseconds
- Loading settings may be incomplete when the settings are from a different device
- μMPX: Incorrect FEC display during dual streaming (CSM-1399)

New Functionality

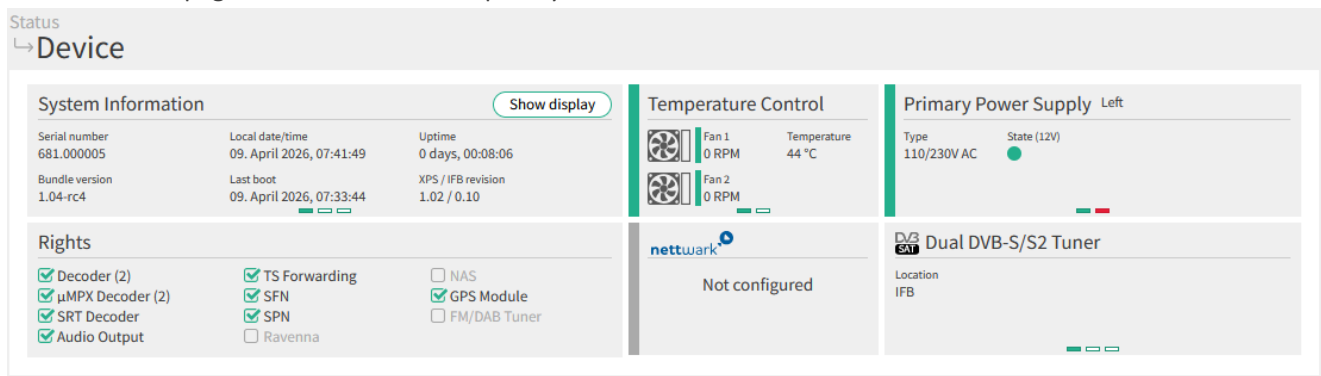
- The list of available Ravenna streams may get long. Now we've added the possibility to filter the list by a freely entered text or by automatically generated tags



- First support for the optional FM/DAB/HD multiband tuner module

Changed Functionality

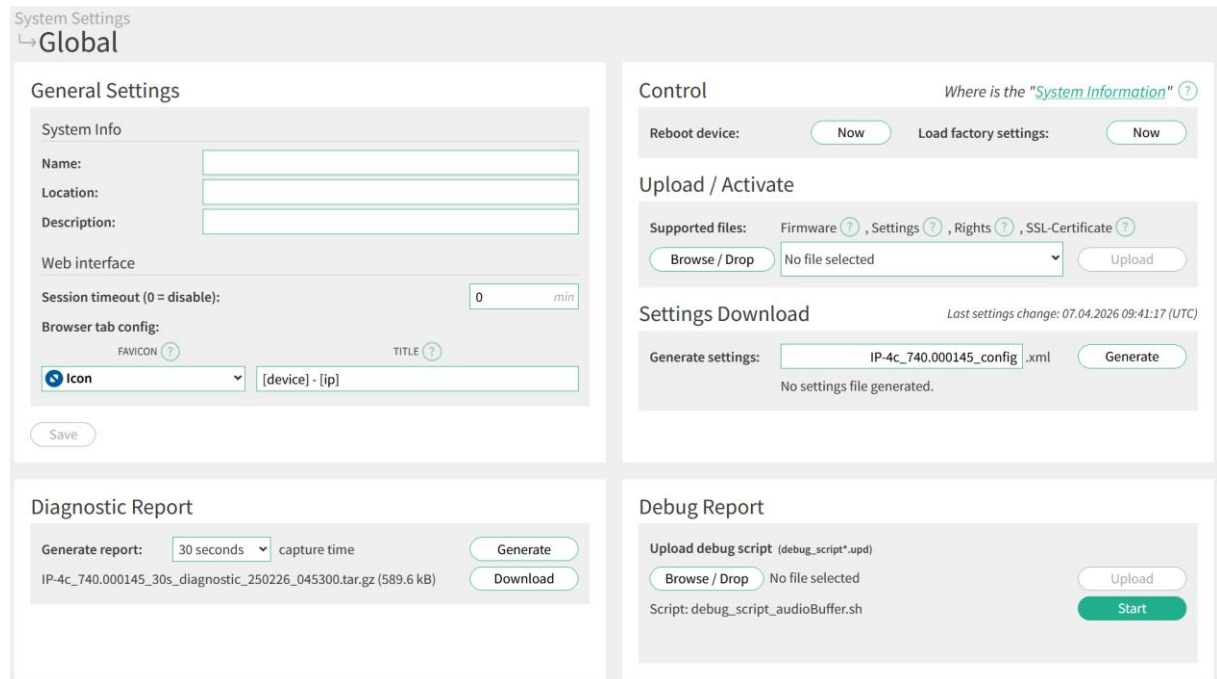
- Added display for the installed SAT tuner (see new Status/Device page)
- The System Information, which was formerly found under System Settings / Global, has been moved to the Status / Device page, which has been completely revised

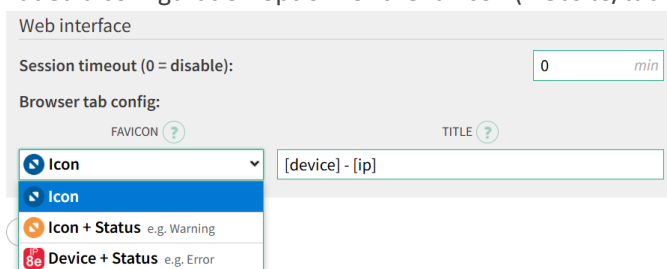

Fixed Issues

- Updated SNMP library for better stability
- Extended the allowed range for the input source gain to -72 up to +12dB (instead of -12 up to +6dB)
- Stability improvements
- Fixed possible crash when loading settings
- Settings file may get generated empty or incomplete
- Fixed hourly reboots in very rare cases under heavy load (CSM-1525)
- Optional MPE Forwarding: fix not working configuration via selection from list

New Functionality

- Added a configuration option for the favicon (website/tab icon)

You now have the possibility to show the overall status of the device via the icon color. You might even show the device type via the icon for better differentiation in case of many open browser tabs.

- Optional new Dual DVB-S/S2/S2X Tuner: fixed wrong RF level display

Changed Functionality

- In case of devices with two power supplies, the power LED will flash red/green, if only one power supply is connected to power. This can now be suppressed by enabling only the power supply alarm for the connected power supply and disabling the alarm for the other one. In this case the power LED will show green. Please note, that for this updated behavior you also must update the System Controller firmware to version 1.08 – you will find this firmware via “Check for updates” from within the web interface in the section “Optional Updates”. (CSM-1260)
- Slight rework of the Storage status page
- The list of present and missing licenses/rights on the System Settings / Global page is now presented in a clearer fashion
