New Functionality

- A MoIN can now be duplicated by selecting “Duplicate MoIN” from its action menu
- Added support for Stereo Tool
- Ember+, SIP and Live Listening Ports are now configurable from the MCU
- License warnings are now displayed in the status bar

Changed functionality

- Administration page was removed in favor of a "Create MoIN" button on the pods overview page
- Refreshed all UI components to better align with corporate design
- Performance grades now includes headroom for Stereo Tool processing

Fixed issues

- Improved MCU performance by optimizing the communication between MCU and API
- Fixed toast message wording after updating a VLAN configuration
- Improved license handler stability by optimizing the configuration
- Fixed an issue where the assigned RAM units were incorrectly converted from 1024 MB to 1 MB instead of 1 GiB
- Fixed crashes during bundle uploads
- Fixed an issue where MoINs would not properly restart or be created after 30 days after installation

Known bugs and limitations

- Creating a VLAN with DHCP on the control interface may result in an unconfigured VLAN. This can be resolved by changing it to a static VLAN.

New Functionality

- User can generate and export system wide logs on MCU Maintenance page
- VLAN priorities can be defined for each VLAN

- Refactor detail modals in MCU ListView

Fixed issues

- DNS settings not propagated to Containers
- MCU performance improved by optimizing the communication between MCU and API
- VLANs cannot be added to existing MoIN pods
- Performance grades are displayed correctly
- VLANS can only be deleted if they are not in use by a one MoIN container
- MCU shows wrong user feedback if MoIN name is already in use
- VLAN dropdown does not stay open on user click
- Select all VLANs button not working properly
- MCU overview page can show wrong pod CPU limits

New Functionality

- New MCU Live-View overview shows configured streams for encoders, decoders and multiplexer concatenated from all MoINs
- MoIN containers can be stopped / started
- Number of encoders and decoders of a running MoIN can be edited
- User can select all VLANs at once during MoIN creation
- Linux realtime kernel (RT) is used instead of regular kernel
- A domain number can be defined for the PTP service

- MCU VLAN bulk actions removed
- MCU network settings dialog changed

- Administration does not show any interfaces if interface count is higher than 4
